ARENA STAGE ANNOUNCES SECOND EXTENSION FOR *THE ORIGINALIST*WITH PERFORMANCES RESUMING MAY 19-31, 2015 AT ARENA STAGE AT THE MEAD CENTER FOR AMERICAN THEATER

(Washington, D.C.) **John Strand**'s acclaimed world-premiere drama **The Originalist**, based on Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, is receiving an unprecedented second extension. The production will run through the May 3 extension date, as previously announced, before **resuming again on May 19 and running through May 31**. The Originalist stars four-time Helen Hayes Award winner and acclaimed D.C. actor **Edward Gero** as the Justice and is under the direction of Artistic Director **Molly Smith**.

Featured alongside Gero, who returns to Arena Stage following his portrayal of legendary artist Mark Rothko in Red in 2012, are **Kerry Warren** (Broadway's *The River*) as Cat, the young clerk who becomes a sparring partner for Justice Scalia, and **Harlan Work** (Taffety Punk's *Charm*) as Brad, an eager Scalia devotee and Cat's opposite in every way.
