With 17 full-time dancers and an administrative team of 7, Step Afrika! is one of the top 5 African American dance companies. The Company reaches thousands each year through a 50-city tour of American colleges and theaters and performs globally as an official U.S. Cultural Ambassador. New work, such as 'The Migration: Reflections on Jacob Lawrence' and 'Drumfolk,' tour to major U.S. cities.
